HELD 3 TIMES
DURING THE YEAR

This course introduces new believers to the earliest Christian discipleship teaching, centred on the two paths Jesus spoke of: the Way of Life and the way that leads to death. You'll learn what it means to choose the Way of Life each day — growing in love, purity, forgiveness, and obedience — and how to leave behind old patterns that hold you back. Along the way, we explore simple early-church practices — baptism, prayer, communion, and living in Christian community — giving you a strong foundation for your new life in Jesus.

Discover Your Design is an encouraging space to help you uncover the unique gifts God has placed within you. Through a simple profile and guided conversation, you'll begin to see how He has shaped your heart, strengths, and passions. Our team will come alongside you to pray, affirm, and help you recognise what God is growing in you. You will gain clarity on opportunities to use these gifts in meaningful ways — both in everyday life and within our church community. But above all, this course is about helping you discover who God created you to be and the beautiful contribution He's already woven into your life.



PRAYER: LEARN TO HEAR GOD'S VOICE

DURING THE YEAR

A practical, biblical course for anyone who is longing to grow closer to God through prayer — whether you're just beginning or seeking to deepen your prayer life. You'll learn how to speak with God in a natural, heartfelt way, how to recognise His voice through the Holy Spirit, Scripture, peace, and godly wisdom and cultivate a daily rhythm of connection with Him. This course will help you slow down, listen well, and cultivate a daily rhythm of prayer that draws you into deeper intimacy with God and greater awareness of His presence in your everyday life.



EVANGELISM & APOLOGETICS

3 SESSIONS

— *Guest Presenters*

This course helps you share your faith in a way that feels natural, compassionate, and true to who you are. You'll learn how to have meaningful conversations about Jesus, listen well, and respond gently to questions or doubts. We also explore simple ways to explain what you believe and why — not through debating, but by reflecting the love and truth of Jesus in everyday conversations.



THE BOOK OF REVELATION

4 SESSIONS

This course offers a simple and faith-building walk through the Book of Revelation, helping you understand the major end-time events, the role of the Church, and the ultimate victory of Jesus. Across four weeks, we explore why these teachings matter, how God's plan unfolds through history, and how believers can live with wisdom, courage, and hope as we look toward Christ's return. The focus is not fear or speculation, but drawing closer to Jesus and learning how to faithfully prepare our hearts for the days to come.



BIBLE: OLD TESTAMENT

4 SESSIONS

A journey from creation to the second temple. How the Old Testament gives us important frameworks in which to look at the Gospel story, and how we should be interpreting these stories within the light of modern Faith. This course is for those who want to understand the narrative of the Old Testament and go deeper into the scriptures.



BIBLE: NEW TESTAMENT

4 SESSIONS

A walkthrough of Jesus' life, the blossoming Early Church, and Revelation's glimpses into the future. This course will look at the New Testament writings through the context of the Roman world to help you read in the context of the original authors.



CHURCH HISTORY

4 SESSIONS

The History of the Church: this course will be looking at how the Church has navigated itself in the lens of history from the Apostolic fathers to the rise of Pentecostalism. This course is for those who want to understand decisions that shaped Christian faith and understand the place of the Church in the world today.
